make a way for and Frank and
Sam has always helped me they
are both young my boy is only
20 and Sam 19 my boy had

never been away from home before
and it was his first trip from home
and he was sentenced from 6 months
to one year his 6 months was up the
8 of March and it was ask to
write to you and tell you my
circumstances which is of this kind
for me to battle alone and my felt
is of this sort I am not writing
this letter to expect sympathy but
to see if you will take it before the
board of Pardon when they meet the
21 of March and see if they will
free my boy for his father is in
after this kind which you can
find out by writing to my Sheriff
