I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary 2<sup>nd</sup> deg.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of Oct. A. D. 1924, at Manti, Utah - County of Sanpete and State of Utah, in District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable H. J. Woolley presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate Term - and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison -

Fourth-- Honorable Dalton prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Thomas Mallahan I was convicted under the name of " O'Brien

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Frank Lear # 4479

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except "Grand Larceny" Nevada State Prison
