Application of James Henderson, No. 4152

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Re-hearing for Termination or Parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary, 2nd Degree

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 10th day of November A. D. 1922, at Coalville County of Summitt and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Ephriam Hansen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an Indeterminate term in the Utah State Prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Ross Hutchinson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is James Arthur Harger I was convicted under the name of James Henderson

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except California
