IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF JAMES HENDERSON FOR A RE\*HEARING

I, James Henderson, being first duly sworn, on oath, deposes and says:

That he is confined in the Utah State Prison, Salt Lake City, Utah, by virtue of a commitment from the 3rd Judicial District Court, County of Summitt, on a charge of Burglary 2nd Degree, having been received November 11th, 1922.

That his application was considered by the Board of Pardons at their meeting held March 20th and 24th, 1925:

That this denial was induced, he believes, by the fact that it was not called to the attention of the Board of Pardons that he is under Federal indictment for the transportation of a stolen automobile, and that letters are on file requesting that he be turned over to them.

Wherefore, affiant now prays for a re-hearing of his application to the end that he may either be paroled from this Prison or granted a Termination of Sentence to be turned over to the Federal authorities. If the Board sees fit to grant a Parole, affiant has the offer of a good position in Salt Lake City, and while on parole, will use his best efforts to secure an adjustment of the case now pending against him in the Federal Courts.

Affiant has now served over two years and nine months of his sentence, and feels that the ends of justice have been served, and that no further good can come from his continued imprisonment.
