and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 26th day of May
A. D. 1924, at City & County Bldg. County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Hon. Judge M. L. Ritchie Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge M. L. Ritchie presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to serve an indeterminate
sentence of from one to twenty yrs.
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison
& was committed thereon on the 15th of
October - 1924

Fourth-- Honorable C. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Fred. Hedner
