APPLICATION OF FRED FIDLER

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF PRISONERS OF THE STATE OF UTAH:

I hereby apply to your honorable body for a rehearing of my application for termination or parole presented to your honorable board on June 26, 1935. My application for rehearing is based upon the following circumstances and conditions:

I

At the hearing of June 26, 1935, I was not represented by counsel and did not know how to present the facts in my case to your board. Since then Mr. W. W. Stoffensen, an attorney at law has volunteered to assist me in this matter and I am advised that the other witnesses surrounding my conviction and the facts brought out at the hearing at the trial at which I was convicted should be presented to your honorable board by some one prepared and who understands them.

That without any solicitation on my behalf, a number of citizens, residents of Logan have presented a petition to your honorable board on my behalf, the original of which is hereto attached and made a part of this application.

III

That my father is a widower and is rapidly losing his health and is unable physically to do the things necessary to provide for himself and his family, and that it is my obligation to assist him in these matters; that there is opportunity now offered in Garb County for work which I can engage in profitably and also be able to assist farmers in their best digging and other matters and use my time to such better advantage than if I remain in this place.

Wherefore, I pray that your honorable body will grant a rehearing at its meeting in September and that I be privileged to
