First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Transporting Liquor

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 16 day of Jan A. D. 1925, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Marks presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate Term from Three months to Six months With and thereafter was imprisoned in the a record of thirty days.

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Alfred Olander Anderson I was convicted under the name of A. O. Anderson

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except I was fined \$45.00 Seventy Five Dollars for possession of liquor
