Application of Joe Tobin

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in W. S. P. under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 3rd degree Burglary.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 9th day of June A. D. 1923, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in 3rd district Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Cherson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Six months to three years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Joe Tobin I was convicted under the name of Joe Tobin

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except in 1919 Utah State Prison -
