I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole
and respectfully represent as follows:

First -- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary

Second -- I was convicted and sentenced on the ninth day of June
A. D. 1923, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in 3rd District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Iverson presiding.

Third -- I was sentenced to Six months to Three years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth -- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth -- My true name in full is Joseph Tobin
I was convicted under the name of Joe Tobin

Sixth -- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: None

Seventh -- I have never been convicted of any offense except in 1919
when I came here for Burglary.
