Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 2nd day of February
A. D. 1929, at Farmington, Utah County of Davis
and State of Utah, in the Second Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Kimbell presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term,
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable David Wilson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Joe Tobin

I was convicted under the name of Joe Tobin
