Application of Joseph E. Tobin

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 2nd day of February A. D. 1929, at Formington County of Davis and State of Utah, in Second District. Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Kimball presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One to Ten Years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable D. J. Wilson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is I was convicted under the name of Joseph E. Tobin

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except Robbery not Arm. And Grand Larceny.
