Application of Edward McGowan #4353.

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 1st Degree Murder

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 11th day of December A. D. 1925, at Price County of Carbon and State of Utah, in 7th District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Christensen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to be executed and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable G. W. Dalton prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Edward McGowan I was convicted under the name of Edward McGowan

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except None

Request that I be granted the privilege of appearing before the Board of Pardons, personally.
