and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Sentenced to be Executed
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Murder 1st Degree.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 20th day of May
A. D. 1922, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third Judicial Dist. Court, Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Ephraim Hanson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to be Executed July 14, 1922.

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison, and thereafter
to wit; one March 31, 1923, I was sentenced to be executed
on the 25th day of May 1923.

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is George H. Gardner

I was convicted under the name of George Gardner

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows:

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except None.
