Application of Jess Short

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First -- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second -- I was convicted and sentenced on the June 5th day of 1924
A. D. 1924, at Edgemoor Utah County of Weber
and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Justice Kimball presiding.

Third -- I was sentenced to an indeterminate sentence
of not less than five years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth -- Honorable Equus Dept. Atty prosecuted the case.

Fifth -- My true name in full is Jess Short
I was convicted under the name of Jess Short

Sixth -- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Earl Jones

Seventh -- I have never been convicted of any offense except the present
one.
