Application of Joseph Alexander

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Twenty-first day of October
A. D. 1921, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Justice L. T. White presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term
of five years to life
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison at
Salt Lake City Utah

Fourth-- Honorable E. C. Pogue prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is James B. French
I was convicted under the name of Joseph Alexander

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: L. E. White, Fred Templeton,

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Grand Larceny
in California
