I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a

Conditional —

and respectfully represent as follows:

First -- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second -- I was convicted and sentenced on the Twenty-first day of October A. D. 1921, at Salt Lake City, Utah County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. B. Wright presiding.

Third -- I was sentenced to an indeterminate sentence of 5 years to Life and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison at Sugarhouse, Utah

Fourth -- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth -- My true name in full is James P. French.

I was convicted under the name of Joseph Alexander.

Sixth -- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: F. Williams, sentenced Dec. 1, 1922, L. E. Hutzell, sentenced June 1924, L. E. White, sentenced June 1925

Seventh -- I have never been convicted of any offense except — Corruption in Utah, — California.

My object is to get for a Conditional Release so I may leave the State of Utah.
