Application of

Joseph Alexander

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Twenty-first day of October A. D. 1921, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in 3rd District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. B. Wright presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an Indeterminate Term and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is James B. French I was convicted under the name of Joseph Alexander

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Fred Lemington, L. E. White, Sentence terminated

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except California and Alcatraz Island Calif.
