Application of James Mendez

and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary in Third Degree

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 14 day of October  
A. D. 1925, at Price County of Carbon  
and State of Utah, in the 7th District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable G. Christenson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to do a term of 6 months  
to 3 years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is James Mendez  
I was convicted under the name of James Mendez.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except None.
