under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 3rd Degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Oct. 14th day of October
A. D. 1925, at Pucci County of Carbon
and State of Utah, in 7th District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Christensen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Six Months - Two Years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Fred Heller prosecuted the case.

I was convicted under the name of James Mendey
