Application of James Mendez No. 5168

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah Penitentiary
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 23 day of March
A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Superior Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Moffitt presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Utah Penitentiary for
indeterminate sentence of 1 to 10 years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah Penitentiary at
Salt Lake City

Fourth-Honorable Ray Van Cott prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is James Mendez
I was convicted under the name of James Mendez

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except Yes-a felony
