First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 19th day of March, A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Moffit presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.
