First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Penitentiary under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 23 day of March A. D. 1929, at S. L. County of S. L. and State of Utah, in 2nd District Court Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Moffitt presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 1 year to 10 Years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah Sate Penitentiary
