First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 26th day of March
A. D. 1931, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable David W. Moffitt presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to one to ten years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Ray Venfitt prosecuted the case.

I was convicted under the name of James Mendez
