First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of December  
A. D. 1922, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Peters presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Five years to life  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Mr. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is William Phillips
