County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Ingers presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Five years to Life  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable C. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is William Philip
