Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 20th day of Dec
A. D. 1923, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake,
and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Everson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Five years to life
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is William Phillips.
I was convicted under the name of William Phillips.
