Application of Harry J. Hamilton

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a parole  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of September  
A. D. 1921, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake,  
and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. B. Wight presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term

and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. Q. Rodgers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Harry Grover Hamilton  
I was convicted under the name of Bitts

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: W. Q. Jones

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except None
