County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge L. B. Wight presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Harry Grover Hamilton  
I was convicted under the name of Ditto
