I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of sentence
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Parole in L. A. Calif
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of burg 2nd Degree Hand Carney

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 27th day of March
A. D. 1925, at Brigham City County of Boulder
and State of Utah, in First Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Melvin E. Harris presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to an indeterminate term
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Lesoy D. Young prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Carl Joseph Wisberry
I was convicted under the name of Jack Wisberry

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: John Winger

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Robbery
at San Diego Calif. 1914 later acquitted
of the same charge.
