I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of sentence
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Persistent Liquor Violation

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 5th day of December,
A. D. 1925, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Wm S. Marks presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to serve an indeterminate sentence
of from 3 months to two years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Edgar A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Andrew Dexas
I was convicted under the name of Andrew Dexas

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except liquor violation.
