Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 8th day of August,
A. D. 1924, at Ogden, Utah County of Weber,
and State of Utah, in Second Judicial Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Geo. S. Barker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Utah State Prison
for a term not exceed 5 years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Arlington Peyton Downing.
I was convicted under the name of A. P. Downing.
