Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of Nov. A. D. 1923, at Ogden County of Weber and State of Utah, in 2nd District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable James H. Kimball presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to one to twenty years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.
