and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 14 day of Nov.  
A. D. 1923, at Ogden County of Weber  
and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable James N. Kimball presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable J. E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is John Luke Rupe  
I was convicted under the name of Same.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: James Boccoch

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except None

Previous record-- San Joaquin County, California.
