I, John L. Rupe, being first duly sworn,  
on oath deposes and says:

That he is confined in the Utah State  
Prison, Salt Lake City, Utah, by virtue of a commitment from the  
Second Judicial District, County of Weber, on a charge of Burglary  
2nd Degree, having been received on November 14th, 1923.

That his application was considered by  
the State Board of Pardons at their meeting on September 26th, and  
same was denied.

Affiant believes this denial of his ap-  
plication for Termination was caused by the fact that no recommenda-  
tion was noted on the Board Calendar, whereas in fact that there had  
previously been a recommendation for One (1) Year received and noted  
on the record book of the prison.

That he was convicted jointly with  
James Bocock, Reg No. 4312, whose sentence was terminated by the Board  
a year ago, and who had the same recommendation as affiant, as is  
shown by the calendar of September, 1924, at which time Bocock's ap-  
plication was considered.

That affiant has been confined here for  
a period of 1 year 11 months and 3 days, ~~am~~ almost double his recom-  
mendation, and during this time he has worked almost every day and  
his conduct in the Prison has been excellent.

Wherefore, affiant prays for a re-  
hearing of his application for a Termination of Sentence, to the end  
that he might secure his release at this time.
