Application of John L. Rupe

On the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary 2nd Degree

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 13th day of November A. D. 1923, at Ogden County of Weber and State of Utah, in Second Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. N. Kimball presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an Indeterminate Term in the Utah State Prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Jos. E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is John Luke Rupe I was convicted under the name of John L. Rupe

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: James Boccock, No. 4312, Terminated at Sept, 1924 meeting of the Board.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except None
