Application of John Neel

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 2nd Degree Burglar

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 16 day of July
A. D. 1923, at Coalville County of Summit
and State of Utah, in 3 District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge G. A. Iverson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to one to twenty years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is John Neel
I was convicted under the name of John Neel

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: John Stine

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except none
