

PETITION FOR PARDON.

TO HIS EXCELLENCY, CHARLES R. MABEY, Governor of the State of Utah, and to the Honorable State Board of Pardon, we the undersigned hereby petition your honorable body, and respectfully ask that John Neel, now confined in the State Prison, and serving a term for the crime of burglary in the second degree, ^{by pardon} and presents herewith the following facts. That on the 8th day of July, 1923, John Neel in company of one John Stine, were arrested for breaking in to one of the buildings in Park City, Utah, John Neel, was drunk at the time of committing the crime; at the preliminary hearing he entered a plea of guilty and was bound over to the Third Judicial District Court, and on the 16th day of July, 1923, was sentenced to serve an indeterminate ^{Sentence} in the State Prison, where he is now confined.

We have known John Neel for several years, and is well acquainted with his family, who are a respectable family living in Poca, Summit County, Utah, where they have resided for many years and where John Neel was born; we feel that in as much as all the property was restored to the party who lost it, and was assisted by John Neel, that he has been sufficiently punished, and that he has paid for his crime, and that this will be a lasting lesson to him, and that justice has been fully complied with.
