under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Sec. Deg. Burglary.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 26 day of Mar.
A. D. 1925, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in The Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Wm S. Marks presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Serve Six Months in the
county jail,
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Salt Lake county jail.

Fourth-- Honorable Mr. Clawson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Albert John Kooyman
I was convicted under the name of Albert Kooyman

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: William Surt and Joseph Frazier

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except 2nd degree
Burglary in the juvenile court in
1924.
