and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 22 day of September
A. D. 1924, at Provo, Utah, County of Utah
and State of Utah, in fourth district Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Ellis Hansen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to fine to life
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable M. Cope prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is John Butcher
I was convicted under the name of Albert H. Bergerson

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Tom Davis

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Colorado
