Application of Albert H. Bergerson #4459

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of Sept.  
A. D. 1924, at Provo County of Utah  
and State of Utah, in 4<sup>th</sup> Dist Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge A. Hensen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to 5 - to - life

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable M. Pope prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is John Butch  
I was convicted under the name of Albert H. Bergerson

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: None Thomas M. Davis

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except in the  
Colorado State Reform school
