Application of Esau Walton No. 4630

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a conditional termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First--That I am serving a term of imprisonment in five years to life under conviction and a sentence on a charge of highway robbery

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 5th day of November A. D. 1925, at Ogden County of Weber and State of Utah, in second district Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable James M. Kimber presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to five years to life

and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison, Salt Lake City, Utah

Fourth--Honorable \_\_\_\_\_ prosecuted the case.

Fifth--My true name in full is Esau Walton

I was convicted under the name of Esau Walton
