I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of sentence, or  
and respectfully represent as follows: Parole to Mr. Emil V. Van Bever, of Santa  
Barbara, California.

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Obtaining money under false pretenses

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 15th day of September  
A. D. 1924, at City and County Building County of Salt Lake  
Salt Lake City  
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable W. M. McGree presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from one to ten years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Ross Hutchinson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Robert Bruce Bayard  
I was convicted under the name of Bruce Bayard

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
