Application of John H. Marshall

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary second degree

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 29 day of Nov, A. D. 1920, at Panguitch County of Garfield and State of Utah, in the District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Henry M. Hoag presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to One to Ten years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison at Salt Lake City Utah.

Fourth-- Honorable E. E. Haffner prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is John Henry Marshall I was convicted under the name of John H. Marshall

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Joseph A. Marshall.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except none at all.
