Application of Ed Collins

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary Second Degree

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 13th day of December A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge McRea presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an Indeterminate Term and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.
