Application of Leonard Edwards

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of February A. D. 1924, at Ogden Utah, County of Weber and State of Utah, in the Second District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge James H. Kimball presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to serve from one to ten years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Leonard Edwards. I was convicted under the name of Leonard Edwards.
