Application of Cornelius Bierman

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison, now on parole
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 13th day of Feby
A. D. 1925, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Wm McCrea presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Salt Lake County Jail until March 14 1925
thereafter in the Utah State Prison, until Feby 20 1926 when I was
paroled to Dr. H. J. Smith of Murray City, Utah

Fourth-- Honorable Geo. Nelson (Asst. Co. Atty.) prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Cornelius Bierman
I was convicted under the name of Cornelius Bierman

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: John W. Mantle and Klaas Bierman

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except the above stated case
