Application of Joseph Eli Warenger.

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 2nd Degree Murder

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 4th day of Sept A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City. County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in 2nd District. Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge McQuinn presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to 20 Years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable D. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Joseph Eli Warenger. I was convicted under the name of Joseph Dupont

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Ralph H. Snybolz and Noel E. White

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except
