To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Pardon
(Exchanged to Cal. Authorities)
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 2nd Degree Murder

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 4th day of Sept.
A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in 3rd District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge McCrea presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an Indeterminate Sentence
Recommendation: 20 years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable J. E. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Joseph Eli Garengeur
I was convicted under the name of Joseph Garengeur

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except

2nd Degree Burglary 1923 California
