Application of Joseph E. Marsenger

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second degree murder.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 10th day of Sept. A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in 3rd District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge W. E. Brea presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to 20 years indeterminate

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable C. H. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Joseph E. Marsenger. I was convicted under the name of Joseph E. Marsenger.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: W. C. White R. W. Seyboldt.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except
