Application of Joe Marenger No. 4443

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Murder

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 4th. day of September A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City Utah County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Wm. McCree presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Five years to life and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable E.A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Joe E. Marenger I was convicted under the name of Joe E. Marenger

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: N. E. White R.W. Seyboldt

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except None
